Instructions and Checklist for KWE Forklift Certification

- □ Identify Forklift drivers needing training (that have not received forklift training within 3 years) and schedule a date to hold the class.
- □ At the beginning of the class, have the attending employees sign the training sign-in sheet. After the last signature, draw a line under it to ensure no one can sign-in after the class was conducted.
- ☐ Have the Employee attend the Du-All Safety live web cast title "Forklift Training Certification".
- □ Have the employees take the two written tests that have been provided by Du- All Safety.
- Review the written tests. Correct the answers with the students in the class.
- □ Using the forklift(s), the supervisor is to demonstrate how to conduct and document the pre-shift inspection.
- □ The Supervisor is to conduct hands-on proficiency training on the forklift with each individual employee and complete an evaluation form for each employee and sign it.
- □ Ensure the forklift poster provided (sent separately) is posted in forklift operating areas. If additional copies are needed, they can be ordered at no charge by calling Du-All Safety at 510-651-8289.
- □ Return the class sign-in sheet, written tests, and evaluation forms to Du-All Safety via e-mail or fax to 510-651-8937. Du-All Safety will send forklift certification cards to you within one week of receipt.
